We then enlarged the pattern to make the shoe a little bigger. (I did not use the lining for the shoes but the link is available above). If you use 2 sided card stock then you get to see the pattern inside the shoe and you don't need to use the lining.

I made a pattern using tissue paper so I could then trace it on to the card stock marking it with tracing paper. Depending what color or print you want on the outside, mark it on the wrong side. After you fold the paper on all the dotted lines the shoe almost falls into shape. I used a hot glue gun and used paper clips to hold it together before gluing. I then added pearls, stones, and ribbons or just cut out matching paper to make a bow or whatever you like. Hope you enjoy making your new shoes.
